

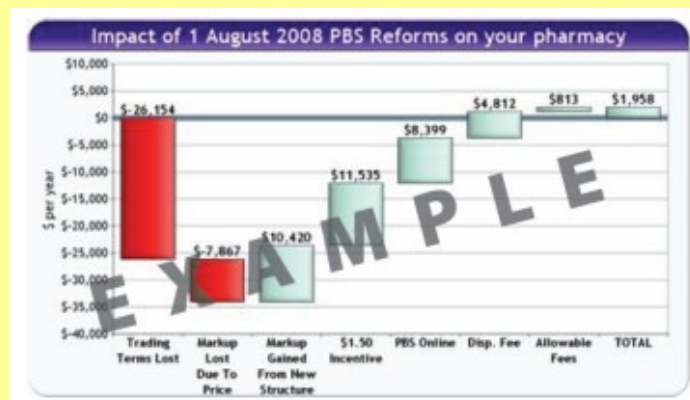

## ScriptMAP

ScriptMAP is a new Guild service, available only to members. The Guild has worked closely with HealthSoft and other vendors to develop a standard data file that members can submit to the Guild for analysis. When you order your ScriptMAP report, you will receive a comprehensive report on the impact of the 1 August 2008 PBS Reforms on your pharmacy, based on your unique pattern of dispensing. The report also includes information to help you understand the reforms, a detailed analysis of your generic substitution rates, and the best areas to target for improvement.

## ScriptMAP

From the *PharmacyPro* Start Menu, go to Tools, Options. On the 'User Details' tab check you have the Owner's name, phone number and email address details correctly entered. From the PharmacyPro Start Menu, go to Reports - Other Reports - ScriptMAP Report.



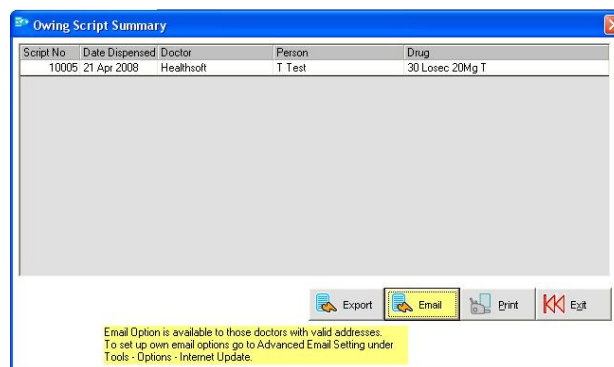
Select the month you want to send and click on OK. If ScriptMAP doesn't work, please contact HealthSoft to check that the .Net framework is installed correctly.

## Emailing an Owing Script Report to a Doctor

You can now quickly send an email to a doctor listing their owing scripts. To set this up, go to Tools – Options – 'Head Office' tab. Click on 'Advanced Email Options', tick the 'Use Advanced Email' option and enter your ISP / email settings.

To email the report, add the doctor's email address in the doctor utility (or go to 'Edit –

Edit Doctor' from the Script screen. After loading the Owing Script report – click 'Email'.



## Automatic Monthly Updates

After running this update you can flag "Auto download monthly updates". The monthly update will then download to your computer a few nights before the 1st, then on the last night of the month it will run the update, do the debtors rollover and forecast overnight and be ready for you in the morning with a message to say what has been done. This will save missed updates and also save time on the busy first day of the month.

To turn this on go to Tools - Options – Click on 'Internet Update' tab, and tick 'Auto Update'.

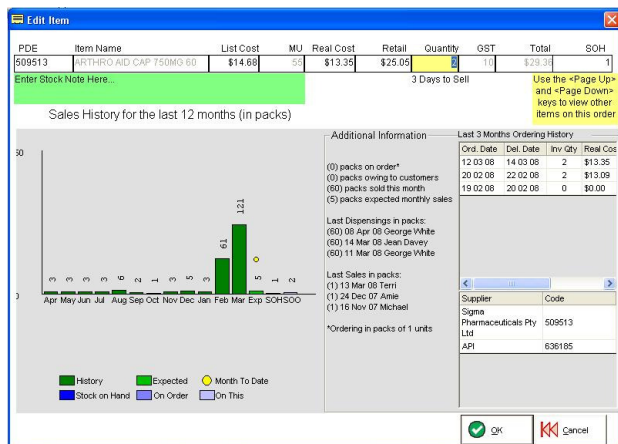
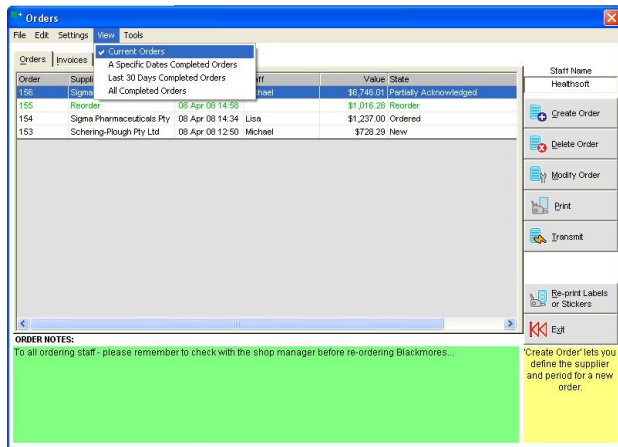
## Save yourself time and increase profits – Let **PharmacyPro** Generate your Orders for you

If you aren't doing so already then order by going to 'Create Order' – General Wholesaler Order. If your SoH is correct then your order will bring up all the things you need (and not those you don't). This is much more efficient than creating blank orders.

## New to Orders

This month you will see some great new features in Orders:

- Leave notes for other staff doing orders (you can leave a note on the main orders screen as well as notes on individual stock items).
- Speed up looking for old invoices or orders by choosing a date range to view.
- View detailed ordering history of stock items on the Edit Item screen.
- View the "Days to Sell" (the number of days it will typically take to sell the ordered quantity) on the Edit Item screen.



## Updating Slave PC's

We have changed the mechanism of downloading from master to slave machines in this update.

After the update, **PharmacyPro** should automatically download all program files in the update from the master computer to all slaves.

## Database Upgrade

If your database hasn't been upgraded, after the May update please follow the instructions below (it is recommended that this is done after hours).

- Do a daily backup first.
- Close **PharmacyPro** on all machines (including master), then shut down all slave machines.
- Open **PharmacyPro** on master machine. (make sure PBSONline is closed before you upgrade your database).
- On the **PharmacyPro** main menu go to Menu on the top: Help - Upgrade Database.
- Wait until the upgrade is finished and Press OK.
- Do a script or sale to see if anything is unusual.
- If there is any problem with a slave machine, please update Slave machine by going to **PharmacyPro** main menu, Help Menu on the top - Update Slave.
