e-Prescriptions

e-Prescriptions were again in the limelight, this time at the Sydney Pharmacy Expo 2009 on 12-14 June, with hundreds of pharmacies signing up. It was great to be able to demonstrate e-Prescriptions to many of you.

We have had Medisecure® integrated with **PharmacyPro** running in pharmacy for over a month now. It increases dispensing efficiency by having the script and patient screens automatically populated with the electronic script information.

eRx Script Exchange integration will be ready very soon.

Patient Screen Flow Changes in Dispense

We have made changes to the look and flow of the patient information screen to allow for e-Scripts. You will notice that more of the patient information has been placed on one screen to allow easier identification and data input.

Database Upgrades

If your database has not yet been updated to the newest version, **PharmacyPro** will print out a fax. Kindly fax this to us on 1800 006 207 and we will arrange a convenient time to upgrade your database.

New Search Criteria in PoS

When selling an item in PoS you can now enter a partcode to bring up an item.

In addition, typing “?” followed by any part of a trade name will allow a wild card search (? is used instead of * as this is reserved for loading scripts).

Chemotherapy Changes

The Chemotherapy changes due to come into effect in September have been implemented in **PharmacyPro** Dispense.

Two new fields called Dispensing Quantity and Unit of Measure have been added to Stock Cards.

Amendments to Restriction Criteria

Please be aware that the July schedule has listed two new item codes for three brands only of Escitalopram Oxalate.

Codes 8700X (10mg) and 8701Y (20mg) apply to 6 brands for Major depressive disorders.

Codes 9432K (10mg) and 9433L (20mg) only apply to Esipram, Esitalo and Lexapro with a list of restrictions.
